



## ELECTION SIGNAGE AUTHORIZATION

Political parties or candidates and/or their representative(s) may place election signage in the Village of Belcarra, upon the written approval of the Superintendent of Public Works with the political representative's signature acknowledging agreement with the following:

"Election signage" includes any and all promotional materials advertising a political party or candidate in a federal, provincial, or local government election.

### 1) TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PLACEMENT OF ELECTION SIGNAGE:

- Election signage is not to be placed prior to 60 days before the day of the election;
- Election signage on Public Property may only be permitted in the specific location(s) described below in Location of Election Signage;
- No more than two large election signs exceeding 0.4 square metres in size but less than 1.49 square metres may be located on public land;
- **Large** election signage including support structures shall not exceed a height of 2.44 metres;
- **Small** plastic bag or coroplast wire support signs shall not exceed a size greater than 0.55 Square Meters or a height of 1 meter above grade;
- Elections signage shall not be unsightly, dilapidated, structurally unsafe, illuminated, a traffic distraction or interfere with the safety of vehicles, cyclists or pedestrians;
- Elections signage is not permitted to be attached to parked vehicles or trailers;
- Election signage shall not visually obstruct, simulate or detract from any traffic control signs;
- Election signage is not to be attached to vegetation, municipal structures or property or newspaper boxes;
- Election signage and support structures shall be removed within 3 days after the date of the election;
- Election signage may be removed for cause if considered by the Superintendent of Public Works as not meeting the requirements of this Authorization.

### 2) LOCATION OF **LARGE ELECTION SIGNAGE** – Entrance to Village:

Large Election signage may only be placed within the North Road Shoulder between the two BC Hydro Power Poles starting inbound on Bedwell Bay Road, 22 metres West of the Municipal entrance sign and ending 38 metres East of the CRAB Notice Board (see photo entrance to Village).

### 3) LOCATION OF **SMALL ELECTION SIGNAGE** – West of Tennis Courts:

Small election signage may only be placed within pull out area located between the large boulders near the tennis courts and the 30K speed (see photo west of tennis courts).

### 4) LOCATION OF **SMALL ELECTION SIGNAGE** – West of Salish Bus Shelter:

Small election signage may only be placed within pull out area located between Turtlehead Road and the Salish Bus Shelter (see photo west of Salish Road).

### 5) ELECTION SIGNAGE ON PRIVATE PROPERTY:

Election signage may be placed on private property pursuant to the Village of Belcarra Zoning Bylaw No. 253, 1996 and amendments thereto.

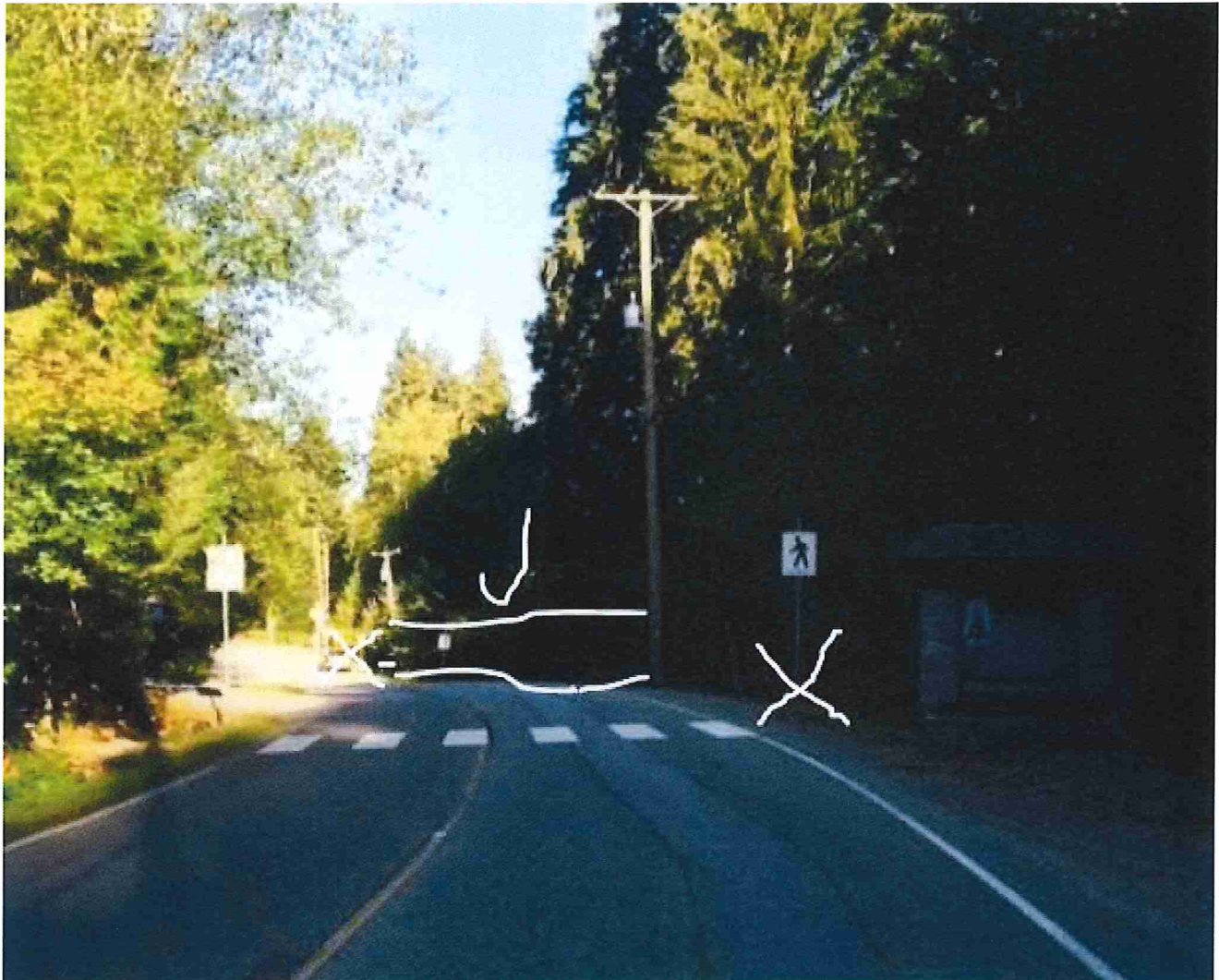
