Bin A	Newspaper	clean, dry newspapers, flyers 	wet or soiled newspaper
	Mixed Paper	office paper, catalogues, phone books, glossy magazines, brown paper, windowed or manila envelopes 	paper towels, carbon, waxed or tissue paper
	Cardboard	clean, dry cardboard, corrugated boxboard 	drink boxes, tetra-paks, gabled poly-coated milk cartons, waxed or soiled cardboard

Bin B	Glass: Jars & Bottles	clean glass bottles and jars (lids off) 	lightbulbs, dishes, pyrex, ceramics, pottery, mirrors or window glass
	Cans: Tin & Aluminum	clean cans, tin, aluminum, metal lids 	soiled items
	Rigid Plastics 	clean milk jugs or other plastic types 1 to 5 only 	plastic types 6 and 7, pesticide or insecticide containers, styrofoam cups or meat trays, bags or plastic film

Please, **NO** Plastic Bags in Bins A or B

Household Refuse Disposal Guide



No Commercial refuse. Refuse must be in a garbage bag, smaller than one metre long, and placed in the bin.
It is an offense to dump outside the bin.

NO	Yard Waste	NO - Grass, Branches, Weeds, Roots, Stumps, Ashes, Sod, Soil, Rocks
NO	Bulk Materials	NO - Carpet, Appliances, TVs, Computers, Stereos, Furniture, Mattresses, Box Springs, Tires, Car/Boat Parts, Used Oil Filters
NO	Building Materials	NO - Lumber, Concrete, Brick, Wallboard/Drywall, Windows, Doors, Piping, Roofing/Siding, Demolition Material
NO	Hazardous Materials 	NO -  Compressed Gas Cylinders - <i>Propane Tanks</i>  Corrosive Materials - <i>Acids, Caustic Cleaners, Car/Boat or other Lead-Acid Batteries</i>  Poisonous Materials - <i>Prescription Drugs, Pesticides, Herbicides, Paint, Solvents, Antifreeze</i>  Flammable Materials - <i>Gasoline, Kerosene or other Petroleum Products</i>  Toxic Materials - <i>Bleach, Ammonia, Asbestos, Acetone, Ni-Cad Batteries</i>  Bio-Hazardous Infectious Materials - <i>Syringes, Animal feces, Carcasses</i> Unidentified Chemicals
