A bylaw for the Administration of the Freedom of Information and
Protection of Privacy Act

The Municipal Council of the Village of Belcarra, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Belcarra Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 477, 2014".
2. "Belcarra Freedom of Information Bylaw No. 213, 1994", together with all amendments to it, is hereby repealed.
3. In this bylaw,
"Act" means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.B.C., 1996 Chapter 165, as amended from time to time;
"Village" means the Village of Belcarra.
4. The definitions contained in Schedule 1 of the Act, shall apply to this bylaw except where the context requires otherwise.
5. The Chief Administrative Officer is designated as the Head for the purposes of the Act.
6. The Superintendent of Public Works is designated as the Information and Privacy Coordinator for the purposes of the Act, and is authorized to perform the duties and functions in the absence of the Head.
7. The Schedule of Maximum Fees as established by British Columbia Regulation B.C. Reg. 155/2012, as amended from time to time, for release of records pursuant to the Act, shall be the maximum fees charged by the Village as permitted under the Act.
8. The Head may designate those records of the Village which are available to the public, upon payment of the applicable fee as specified in the Fees and Charges Bylaw, without a request for access under the Act.
