Dear Neighbours of Tum Tumay Whueton Drive & Visitors of Belcarra Regional Park,

FC Productions Inc is applying to the Village of Belcarra to film scenes for the upcoming series "Fire Country" within Belcarra Regional Park on Friday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 from approximately 7:00am until 3:00pm. This rescheduled work from our previously notified February 03<sup>rd</sup>. As we were unable to complete this work due to weather. The scenes that we will be filming will involve our picture Fire Trucks traveling along Tum Tumay Whueton Road. Production will be utilizing BC Road Safe for our traffic closure during this time. Public & neighbours may be asked to detour along Bedwell Bay Road.

The following is an outline of our proposed filming dates, times, locations, and significant actions.

**Friday, February 17<sup>th</sup>:**

**7:00am** Road Closure will be put into place as site preparations begin.

**9:00am – 12:30pm**

- With the assistance of BC Road Safe, Tum Tumay Whueton Road will be closed from the intersection of Tum Tumay Whueton Drive & Thermal Plant Road to Belcarra Regional Picnic Parking Lot.
- Thermal Plant Road will be open & access will be maintained for vehicles.
- Vehicles can use the detour route along Bedwell Bay Road as an alternative to access Belcarra Picnic area.
- Production Assistants will be posted at the beginning of our safety lockup & Tral heads along the route to inform public of what is occurring & direct them to alternate access to the park.
- An Ariel Drone will film scenes on Tum Tumay Whueton following multiple pictures cars driving along Tum Tumay Whueton Road.

**12:30pm – 2:00pm**

- Closure on Tum Tumay Whueton Drive remains in effect.
- Production will adjust our lockup to include intermittent traffic control along Thermal Plant Road. (03-05min)

**2:00pm – 3:00pm**

- Equipment is packed into trucks & crew leave the area.

**3:00pm**

- Tum Tumay Whueton Road will re-open to neighbours & patrons.
