

NOTICE OF FILMING & TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

Monday, February 20, 2023

Dear neighbours of Belcarra Regional Park,

Please take a moment to read this notice about the filming of the seventh season of the television series "Riverdale" for the CW Network. We will be filming exterior scenes within Belcarra Regional Park on **Wednesday**, **February 22 & Thursday**, **February 23**, **2023**.

Shadow Lake Films would like to provide some information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity might affect your daily routine. Here is a summary of our plans:

Tuesday, February 21, 2023

8:30am - 6:00pm Small crew prepares the area for filming. Prep work will take place on Tum Tumay

Whueton Drive between Thermal Plant Road & the Belcarra Picnic Area.

Wednesday, February 22, 2023

6:00am – 6:00pm Crew and work trucks arrive.

6:00pm – 3:00am (Thurs) Filming exterior scenes on Tum Tumay Whueton Drive. The scenes involve a vehicle

that drives and picks up actors who are hitch hiking beside a broken down car on the side

of the road.

Thursday, February 23, 2023

7:00am – 1:00pm Crew return and prepare the area for filming.

1:00pm – 3:00am (Fri) Filming exterior scenes on Tum Tumay Whueton Drive. The scenes involve a vehicle

driving down the road and actors wrestling on the side of the road.

2:00am – 6:00am Equipment will be packed. Crew and work trucks while quietly depart.

Friday, February 24, 2023

7:00am - 7:00pm Small crew returns to wrap the location.

For safety and continuity of picture, Tum Tumay Whueton Drive will be TEMPORARILY CLOSED from Wednesday, February 22 at 7:00am to Friday, February 24 at 2:00pm. Motorists can access the Belcarra picnic area from Bedwell Bay Road during this time. Signage will be in place for the alternative detour route

We emphasize the traffic changes are temporary and we appreciate your cooperation during this time.
