METAL AND WIRE THEFT

Metal theft is a growing and challenging problem that tends to be underestimated. Thieves target all kinds of metals which can include catalytic converters in cars, copper boat propellers, metal roof gutters, and fencing. Wire from street lamps and telephone cables are also vulnerable.

HOW DOES METAL AND WIRE THEFT IMPACT YOU?

Metal and wire thefts can result in 9-1-1 service disruptions, power outages, communication system outages (such as phone, television or internet) and increased costs to services.

REPORTING CRIME
